

WELCOME (BACK) TO SCHOOL!

The PTFA (Parents, Teachers and Friends' Association) would like to welcome all students and parents to Furze Platt Senior School, whether you are returning for another year or joining us for the first time.

The PTFA is a registered charity and run by a small committee of enthusiastic volunteers. Like the PTFAs you may be familiar with from your junior school, our main role is fundraising. However, we don't tend to do large scale events that demand lots of manpower, such as Christmas and Summer Fairs (and the Friday afternoon ice cream sales – although we quite miss those!). At Furze Platt Senior School, while running one or two one-off events, over the past few years we have raised our most significant funds through regular contribution schemes like the 200 Club, second-hand uniform sales, and Easy Fundraising.

All funds are raised for the benefit of the school, and over the past year things we have funded include new lab coats and science calculators for the Science Department, tools for the Gardening Club, lathes for the Engineering Department, equipment for Duke of Edinburgh Award expeditions, and storage boxes for the Construction Department. Additionally we funded prizes for the Sports Awards and the prizes for the Celebration Evening last


