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WILLIAMS FORMULA 1 STEM RACE DAY – YEAR 7 ENRICHMENT TRIP



Some of our Year 7 students recently had an exciting opportunity to visit Williams Racing F1 for a STEM Race Day, designed to bring science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) to life in the world of motorsport. The day included hands-on activities such as the Williams Composites Challenge, an Esports simulator experience, and a guided tour of the Williams Racing Museum. One of the highlights was the chance to try out the racing simulators, where students had great fun experiencing the precision and skill required to drive like a professional. This unique experience helped them see how STEM subjects are applied in real-world settings, making their learning even more engaging and relevant.

Beyond the exciting activities, the trip was a valuable personal development opportunity, encouraging students to think about their futures and explore career possibilities within motorsport and engineering. A Q&A session with Williams Racing professionals gave insight into the diverse roles within the industry, from engineering and aerodynamics to data analysis and esports. Many students left feeling inspired, with a greater appreciation for STEM subjects and the career pathways they can lead to. It was a fantastic experience, and we look forward to providing more enrichment opportunities like this in the future.

Fantastic news from two of our ex students this week!

Craig Johnston is in the semi-finals of the Roux Scholarship to find Britain's best young chef. Already crowned 'Masterchef: The Professionals' winner in 2017, he subsequently worked at The Boathouse at Boulters Lock and the former Royal Oak in Paley Street (now The Braywick) before becoming Head Chef at Marcus in 2021. He currently works at London's Michelin starred Angler Restaurant as Head Chef.



In a previous interview Craig said: "I first became interested at an early age but I didn't really click in my head as something I'd want to do as a career, until I was cooking at [Furze Platt Secondary] School and realised I was good at it. I was always quiet at school but encouragement from my Food Tech teacher led me into this career."

Sporting superstar Frank McGrath won a Silver medal in the English National Cross Country Championships with PB Racing Squad last week. This adds to a fantastic tally of medals this season as Frank has also recently won Gold at the South of England Championships and Silver at the All Ireland Cross Country Championships.




