I work in technology so wanted to bring that business expertise to the Governing Board and help grow the School's already strong focus on STEM.

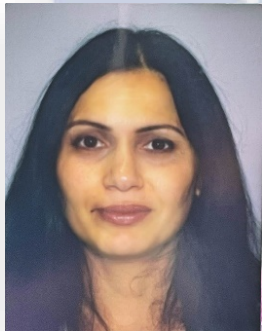
I'm an enthusiastic quizzer and help run the twice yearly PTFA quiz night to raise much needed funds.
